## Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the January meeting were reviewed and approved. A motion to approve minutes was made by Dr. Murray and seconded by Steve DiTommaso. All present voted in favor. APPROVED

## PTA Officers Reports

## Treasurer's Report - Steve DiTommaso

- Balance Update
  - o Beginning balances
    - First National Bank (FNB) \$21,150
      - There were 6 deposits, including box tops (\$19), spiritwear (\$1050), decals sold at Sunny Funny Fair (SFF) through spiritwear (\$30), a \$25 donation, PayPal transfer, and interest
      - There were 3 checks written to MTLSD for PTA copier use, and reimbursements for Howes About a Gift (\$183) and Spiritwear (\$27) expenses
    - There are outstanding checks for PTA dues and the 5<sup>th</sup> grade wolf conservation fieldtrip, both of which are budgeted items.
    - PayPal \$37 from membership payment and SFF revenue transferred to FNB. Ending balance \$0

- With the budget surplus of the SFF, Dr. Murray mentioned doing something special for the 5<sup>th</sup> graders
  - For example, pay for all of Camp Guyasuta or buy a yearbook for every fifth grader.
  - Steve will reach out to 5<sup>th</sup> grade committee with the ideas.

## VP Report – Dr. Murray

- National Random Acts of Kindness Week (Feb 14-18)
  - o There is a building-wide service project to collect nonperishable food for SHIM

- Feb 18 will be a noon dismissal day
  - All K-12 staff will listen to guest speaker Ali Michael, who is an accomplished Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion speaker, author, and blogger
  - On Sunday Feb 21 there will be an event at the high school with Ali that is open to the community
- In additional to COVID pool testing, Test to Stay will also be starting up soon. This offers the chance to get a rapid test at school and, if negative, the child can have the option to stay rather than be sent home.
- PSSAs are coming up April 25 May 6 and preparations are underway. Schedules are being arranged, so that testing can be in the morning. Lists for small group testing are also being prepared where appropriate.
